

Short Term Missions/Intern Opportunities

My Father's Arrows is a not for profit ministry to orphans. We are looking for young adults to serve in short term mission assignments to provide respite and support services for the primary caregivers at Mama's House and to foster children and families in our community. The children at Mama's House are raised in a family setting by missionaries who are trained and licensed foster parents, where they learn to trust grown-ups again, receive the love of Christ, build responsibility, and are educated in our trauma informed environment as a means of building a solid foundation and breaking the cycle of abuse. Mama's House is nestled among 20 acres of rural farm land.

We are looking for individuals who have a heart for children. The right applicant will identify with our core values and have calm, nurturing, open minded, team oriented approach in caring for children. This applicant must have a servants heart, willing to work hard, and have the flexibility needed to adjust to the children's current needs.

Ideally, our short term missionaries/interns commit to a 3 month trip with us, although length of service is flexible based on individual needs/availability. Long term missionaries who serve as foster parents commit to a minimum of 2 yrs service. Daily activities may include: laundry, cooking, cleaning, childcare, errands, teacher's assistant, animal husbandry, farm and aquaponics, donation processing, event planning, and property maintenance.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 17 years old (short term), 21 yrs old (long term)
- Ability to follow schedules
- Must pass background screening
- Good communication skills, teamwork, integrity, humility, and teachability are necessary
- Attend church services with children who choose to go
- Participate in community outreach services with children
- Maintain a home environment that models healthy Christian family living for children
- Maintain a neat and organized personal space
- Maintain an environment that is joyful, relaxing and peaceful within the structure of the home
- Interact with all children in our care and all staff at all times with appropriate voice tone, level and pitch, language used and gestures and physical movements.
