This time the transition to MFA was less intimidating and went more smoothly because Rose already knew that she would be safe at MFA and that she was loved by her MFA family.....and the horses!



With this in mind, we take a different approach to the holidays. We do have celebrations, but in a less stimulating, more trauma informed style.



We also have traditions, but they are 'MFA Family Style'. During the week leading up to Thanksgiving, we ask each of the children to write down what their favorite holiday dish is from home as well as something they are thankful for. We purchase the ingredients and on Thanksgiving day we fix and serve EVERYONE'S favorite dish.....yes, all 40 of them!

As we eat our favorites, we reminisce about why we're thankful as we purposefully cultivate an attitude of gratitude in their beautiful souls.

Acts 16:31 says, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house."


