One family recently shared,

We felt a great peace leaving our daughter at MFA.... we were reminded to sleep, rest, and to go on dates. The kindness and grace during that phone call further put us at ease knowing that our daughter was being cared for so that we could care for ourselves."

Whether due to behavioral challenges, medical complexities, or unsafe environments, they are making a selfless choice to seek the best care for their child. For many of our children, this was their first time seeing snow, and boy did they get to see it! We received eight inches of snow!

At first, they watched in awe as the tiny flakes drifted from the sky, uncertain if it was real. But as the snow began to settle, their hesitation turned into uncontrollable excitement. Laughter echoed as they ran outside, catching flakes on their tongues, building snowmen, and even taking a sled ride behind a horse! Our horses were just as excited as the children to play in the snow.

For children who have faced so many hardships, this unexpected gift from God was a reminder of life's beauty and wonder.

Moments like these are precious because they allow our children to simply be children—to experience joy, to feel carefree, and to be reminded that just like snowflakes, they are beautifully and wonderfully made, one of a kind works of art.

We made the most of it and even took two snow days; a first in MFA history! They were days filled with warmth, despite the cold. The staff also joined in the fun, making snow angels, having snow ball fights, and sharing hot chocolate afterward. For many of them, this was their first time seeing snow as well. The smiles on their faces were unforgettable.

Just as snow covers everything in a pure, white blanket, God's grace covers us completely, bringing renewal and hope.

A Place of Safety, Growth, and Restoration

incredible transformation takes place when children step into an environment where they feel truly seen and truly safe. Many of the children who come into our care have faced hardships that no child should ever endure—abuse, neglect, trauma, and deep feelings of abandonment. Here, they find more than just shelter; they find security, love, and a place where healing begins.

Residential care provides the stability these children need to grow emotionally, mentally, and spiritually. Through counseling, education, and a structured, nurturing environment, they begin to understand their worth and potential. More importantly, they are introduced to the lifechanging truth of God's love and His power to restore. Healing doesn't happen overnight, but with time, patience, and faith, we see children begin to trust again, to dream again, and to believe that their past does not define their future.

One young woman who has now left our program recently shared,

"God places us exactly where we need to be at this moment – for a reason, a purpose, for our good, and for His glory. Hearing this truth was profoundly moving, and it reminded me of the many times you all shared similar words with me. Back then, I didn't fully grasp or appreciate what you were trying to tell me. But now, looking back, those words have taken root in my heart."

Her words reflect the lasting impact of this ministry. Because of the love, patience, and wisdom poured into her, she now walks in confidence, knowing that God has a purpose for her life. This is the heart of what we do—offering children a path to healing, a foundation of faith, and a future filled with hope.









Embracing New Beginnings

As we stand on the threshold of spring, we are reminded of the beauty of new beginnings. The cold and barrenness of winter are fading, giving way to warmth, growth, and the promise of brighter days ahead. At our children's home, we see spring as a powerful reflection of the hope and transformation that takes place in the lives of the children we serve.

As we enter this new season, let us be reminded of *Isaiah 43:19, "Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."* God is always working, bringing life where there was once despair, making a way where there seemed to be none.

Thank you for being part of this journey with us. Because of your support, children who once felt lost now have a future filled with hope. May this spring be a reminder to us all that with God, every season holds the promise of new beginnings.
