The children who come to our home may have endured difficult pasts, but we have the joy of witnessing God's work in their lives. who struggled with trust when he first arrived. His past experiences had taught him that people leave, that love is conditional, and that hope is fleeting. But as time passed, through the patient love of our staff and the steady encouragement of God's Word, we saw a transformation. Jacob began to open his heart, to believe that he was truly loved, and to trust that God had a plan for his life. Today, he is thriving—doing well in school, laughing freely, and even leading prayers during devotions. What a testimony to the faithfulness of God!

The rains of life may sometimes feel overwhelming, but we hold fast to the promise found in *Deuteronomy 11:14 (KJV):* "That I will give you the rain of your land in his due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil."

God's blessings come in their appointed time. Even when we do not yet see the harvest, we trust that He is at work, nourishing the seeds of faith, hope, and love in the hearts of these children.


